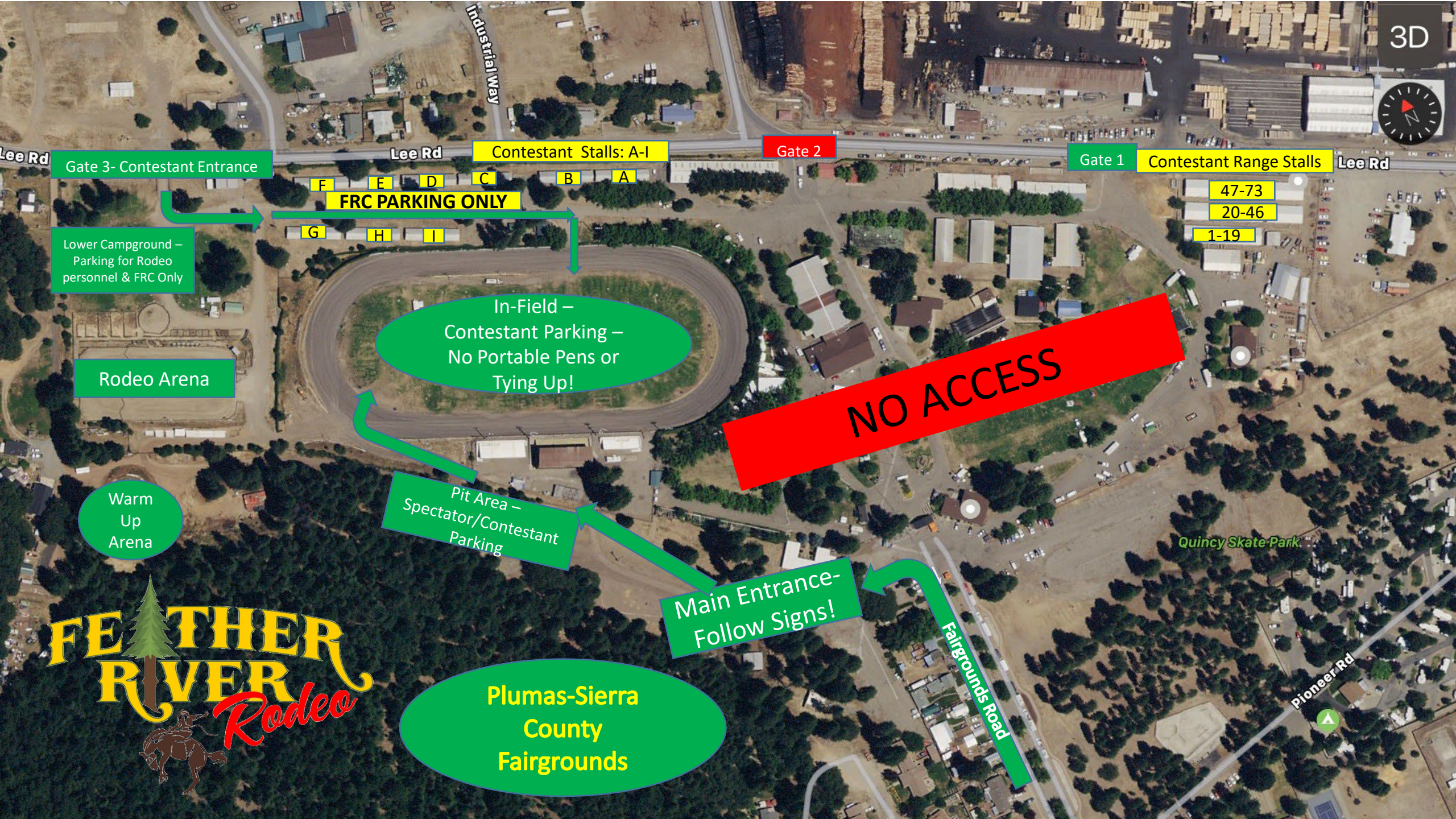

FRC Rodeo Ground Rules

1. All contestant parking is located in the in-field of the race track and pit area... building pens in not permitted on the infield. Only in the pit area will pens be allowed to be built or horses tied up.
2. FRC Contestant parking between stalls only.
3. Only contestants and authorized personnel around the arena area. All contestants must be in Western attire and team vest if they are in the arena one hour prior to the performance.
4. All contestants must park in designated areas- there will be signage.
5. All dogs must be on leash.
6. No warming up horses on infield.



FRC Rodeo Additional Info

- Contestants will pay entry fees to Regional Secretary – Shauna. Look for her motorhome near the arena. All contestants must pay their fees in **cash** prior to competing.
 - \$80/first event, \$40/each event after
 - Don't forget, our rodeo is a one header **and** a long/short go meaning two separate rodeos- (double fees)
- Due at FRC Rodeo- \$75 awards fee
- We will throw the bulldogging steers and tie the calves down on Thursday night at 5pm.
- We will tie goats down Friday morning at 7am.
