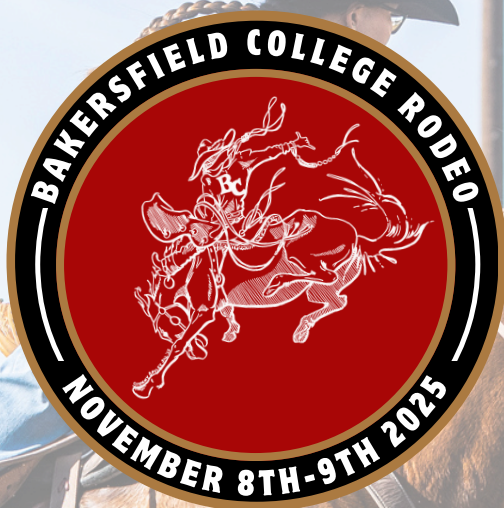


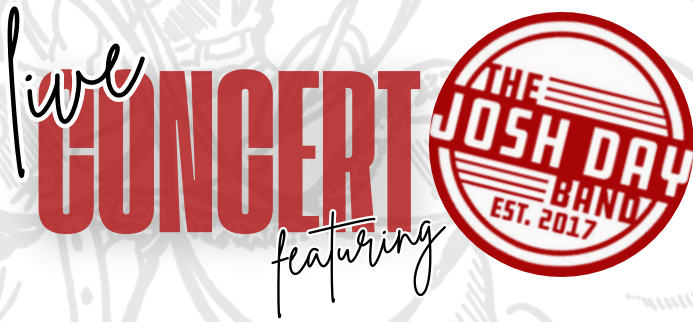

# General Information

- All contestants must register individually and pay online by **Saturday, November 1st, 2025. This is BC registration only, it does not include NIRA entries.**
- This is a Two-Day Rodeo Event, Saturday and Sunday. (see detailed schedule)
- Contestants (truck/trailer/campers) will enter through **gate 32 ONLY** (see map)
- Gate opens Friday, November 7th, not before 12 noon.
- Gates close Friday at midnight.
- Each Contestant must check in at the BC Rodeo Trailer before checking in with NIRA Secretary (see map).
- Registration check-in will be at BC Rodeo Trailer:
  - Friday 11/7 from 3pm-9pm
  - Saturday 11/8 from 8am-noon
  - NIRA check-in will happen at Fresno Rodeo
- All contestants must have a wristband secured by the BC Rodeo Staff at check-in. This will allow for entry through any manned gate. Contestants without a wristband must purchase a ticket to watch any performance.
- Food and merchandise vendors will be open and available on the grounds (cash, apple pay, or credit card - ATM located under grandstands)
  - Friday 3pm-10pm (some food vendors will be open)
  - Saturday 8am-11pm
  - Sunday 8am-3pm
- Overnight stays (camping) are welcome, and encouraged, but you must purchase a camping pass- this is a fair management requirement. see page 5
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- If planning to stay off-site, Hotel options are included on page 6
- The Hospitality Tent will be available to all rodeo contestants and coaches beginning Saturday at 9am through Sunday at 3pm. This is a free tent full of snacks and drinks for all rodeo contestants, coaches, and judges!
- **Salty's BBQ will be serving a FREE tri-tip and pulled-pork lunches on Saturday for all contestants, judges, and coaches from 11AM-1:30PM.**

# Stalls

- \$50 per stall for the weekend, one horse per stall.
- No refunds on stalls.
- Absolutely No Tie-up or portable pens will be allowed.
- Stalls will be grouped by college and located next to camping and trailer parking sites.
- Stalls are not covered - please be prepared with blankets and sheets should we have rain.
- Water is located within the grass area. Bring hoses and expect to carry water to your pens.
- Shavings can be added to your stalls but must be removed.
- All stalls must be cleaned out upon departure - \$100 fine if manure, shavings or trash is left behind. Trash bins will be located in stall area.
- NO Warm up of horses allowed near stalls or on grass.
- Warm up area is located at Jimmy Rogers Arena - see map.

# Camping

- Anyone staying overnight on the fairgrounds must purchase a camping pass through **online registration**.
- Window chalk permit numbers will be added to vehicle and trailer upon arrival.
- Dry Camping - \$50/weekend
- Hook-Ups (water/power) are limited and \$100/weekend
- Anyone without a permit number will be fined \$100 and reported to NIRA.
